Miller Named 2010 State Auctioneer Champion at State Fair

An Oconomowoc auctioneer has taken top honors in the annual bid-callers competition held at the Wisconsin State Fair this month. Carol Miller of Bailey's Honor Auction Service won the event, which is sponsored by the Wisconsin Auctioneers Association. She will serve as WAA's ambassador throughout the year conducting media interviews, and will represent WAA in the International Contest at the National Auctioneers Conference and Show next July in Orlando, Florida.

"I'm so proud and humbled to be named the champion auctioneer," Miller said. "It's a great honor for me to be the first woman to hold the title."

Bailey's Honor, named after Emma Bailey, the first woman auctioneer, specializes in antiques, collectibles and real estate at auction.
